November Activities

Thursday 21 NOV Meeting: GAR Hall Boscobel, 7 PM. Committee of the whole nominated elective officers for 2003. They are: Dan Chroninger – Commander; Garret Reynolds – Senior Vice Commander; Brian Ewing – Junior Vice Commander; Gary Young – Secretary; Tom Truog – Treasurer; Acting Commander appointed Gary Young as Commander of the Camp Guard in the rank of 2nd Lieut.

Wednesday 27 NOV Secretary Young represented the Sons at a meeting in Lancaster between the Woman's Relief Corps and the Grant County Properties Board. Spoke in support of the WRC's claim of ownership of the Hutfil Flag, CSA.. Properties Board passed a resolution requesting WRC give the flag to the county. The WRC disputes their claim to ownership.

December Activities

Tuesday 3 DEC Secretary Young met with Pro Bono lawyer regarding WRC Hutfil Flag ownership...support to the WRC. Then met with the WRC at the Boscobel GAR Hall and informing

them of legal advice. Also discussed and signed agreement with the Boscobel Grand Army of the Republic Hall Preservationists, Inc. for Camp \$49 use of the Hall for meetings and ceremonies. Agreement requires \$10 per month rental. Secretary Young was received as a member into their corporation and issued a key and alarm codes for the Hall so Camp #49 will have reasonable access to the hall for meetings, ceremonies and maintenance. Gary Young was tasked to prepare, with the assistance of legal counsel, a letter to the Grant County Board regarding the Hutfil Flag.

December Meeting Thursday 19 December in the GAR Hall in Boscobel at 7PM. The Hall is located on the South side of Mary Street (CHY MS), 3 blocks east of SHY 61. Important Issues:

1. Final nominations and election of officers for 2003

4. Hall Preservation projects prioritization. Vote on new applicants/members.
5. Planning for installation of officers in January 2003.
6. Formally establish dues and fees for 2003.
7. Other business as placed on the agenda by the Acting Commander
